Class Description:

This course is designed for students who wish to take a more professional approach towards performing. In this elite course, students will have access to individualized audition coaching as well as more performance opportunities in the area! Each week students will learn advanced techniques, as well as prepare material to performance level.

Students must audition to be accepted into this class. (Maximum class size: 14)

Company Members:

Parkway Playhouse Junior Company Instructors are looking for highly driven students who are passionate about theatre and performance. The Company will be comprised of students who truly enjoy all of the hard work it takes to entertain an audience.

Auditions:

August 11 from 2:30-4:30pm

Students should plan to stay for the full audition time.

Those auditioning should be prepared to present a monologue (45-60 seconds) and 32-bars of a song, as well as participate in a dance audition. Please also bring a headshot (if you have one) and a resume.

Schedule:

Regular Class Times: Wednesdays 5:00-6:30pm

The company will stay together for the full conservatory year. Students audition in the Fall term. We will not be holding auditions to add more students in the Spring.

Company will be asked to perform outside of the regular class times.

Unexpected performances will arise, so please make every effort to be available when asked.

Attendance:

Attendance is mandatory for this class. In order for all students to be successful, absences will not be tolerated. Each student is allowed three (3) absences each semester, six (6) for the full conservatory calendar year. If a student exceeds the allotted absences, they will be removed from the class. Please do your best to ensure that your student is present and on time.

Dress Code/Class Expectations:

During practice, you must dress in appropriate attire, meaning comfortable clothes you can move in (no short skirts or tight jeans). You are allowed to bring water bottles into practice. Food and other drinks are prohibited.

Company Etiquette:

The Parkway Playhouse Junior Company is an AUDITION ONLY group where we accept only the top students in talent but most importantly behavior. All Company members are expected to be well-behaved, courteous, honest and able to abide by the rules.

Attitudes that are disrespectful, uncooperative or hurtful do not have a place at Parkway Playhouse. Company members are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that is respectful to others and to themselves. They will not speak negatively about one another or the instructors. This is a Bully Free Zone. All members of the Parkway Playhouse Family must maintain this bully free environment. In the event of multiple infractions, students may be asked to leave Company.
