1 male, 4 female

Gerald (male)

Age: 16+up

A lumbering, somewhat formally attired elephant; prone to melancholy. Best friends with Piggie.

Piggie (female)

Age: 16+up

An ebullient, inquisitive pink pig. Best friends with Gerald.

The Squirrelles (female)

Age: 16+up

Vocal range: E3 to Ab5

A trio of back-up singing squirrels; friends with Gerald and Piggie.

Dog

Age: 16+up

A dutiful delivery dog.

Penguin

Age: 16+up

A sarcastic ice cream seller.

AUDITION PROCEDURES:

Parkway Playhouse is a Community Theater and welcomes EVERYONE regardless of skill-level or experience. We know that auditioning can be stressful and daunting. To facilitate the most positive, welcoming and stress-free audition experience we are offering two audition options. One audition will be specifically for experienced auditioners, the other for inexperienced auditioners. Each performer may choose to attend either audition, though we respectfully request that you honor the spirit of this offering – if you are an experienced auditioner, please attend the designated audition. Auditioners may be asked to attend a callback audition at the discretion of the director. All auditioners will be considered for all roles.

Experienced Auditioners:

Sunday, February 13, 3:00pm – 5:00pm

Please come prepared with a one-minute monologue (not necessarily from the show being cast), 32 bars of sheet music for an accompanist for a musical audition (musical pieces from the show we are casting are acceptable, but not required), please bring a resume and, if you have one, a headshot.

Less Experienced Auditioners:

Saturday, February 12, 2:00pm – 4:00pm

Sunday, February 13, 1:00pm – 3:00pm

Rather than preparing a monologue, you will be given sides (portions of the script) to read from. If you'd like to be considered for the musical, you should be prepared to sing part of a song of your choice. You're welcome to provide sheet music for the accompanist or sing without music. If you have a headshot and/or resume, please bring them.

COVID audition procedure: Masks are required at all times during the audition.

REHEARSAL AND PERFORMANCE LOCATIONS:

Rehearsals will be held at the Mountain Heritage Center located at 113 Green Mountain Drive in Burnsville and at Parkway Playhouse, located at 202 Green Mountain Drive. Performances will tour all libraries within Avery, Mitchell and Yancey Counties as well as offer select park/outdoor productions. Any/all known conflicts should be disclosed prior to or at auditions and confirmed at the first company meeting.

Additional calls for the purposes of costume fittings, research, PR, and other issues pertaining to production will be scheduled as needed by the Production Manager/Stage Management.

COVID rehearsal procedure: Masks are required at all times during rehearsals.
